Last year there were over **2,000** reports of abuse or neglect of vulnerable adults in Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly

Whether you work with people who have support needs or not, safeguarding vulnerable adults 'at risk' is **everybody's business**. Vulnerable adults includes those with mental ill health and drug issues and age range from 16 years old, so those transitioning from young person to adult, which is an important issue for the sector.

This half-day workshop has been specifically designed for people working in the voluntary and community sector to help them understand their role and responsibilities and to be able to respond appropriately to any concerns they may have.

The workshop will enable you to:

- Become familiar with the legal duties we all have with regard to adults who may be 'at risk' of harm.
- Explain who these duties apply to and how to recognise abuse and neglect.
- Recognise your role and the roles of others in responding to concerns.
- Develop an action plan to support your organisation to embed effective safeguarding practice.
